

## War in Ukraine also affects high-tech companies. Industry experts back sanctions against Russia

At the present time, 48% of the companies surveyed are directly or indirectly affected by the war in Ukraine. For 3% of the companies, the situation is even highly critical. 49% of the respondents stated that their own company is not currently affected by the war in Ukraine.



With regard to the general impact on the entire European high-tech industry, the majority (52%) of respondents expect to see significant effects. 3% even expect devastating effects in various areas of the high-tech industry.

Furthermore, 14% of the experts were still unsure at the time of the survey whether effects of the war will be felt in Europe, 31% were confident and do not expect any further effects on the industry.



Regarding the sanctions imposed on Russia, the industry experts were united: the sanctions are at least appropriate, if not too weak. None of the respondents stated that the sanctions were too drastic or that no sanctions should be imposed.

## About the IVAM Executive Panel

The IVAM Executive Panel is the mood indicator for the microtechnology industry. Experts from business and science comment on a current topic from the fields of business, politics, or society. For this purpose, we conduct short surveys among selected executives in mainly small and medium-sized companies and leading scientists in Germany and further European countries.

29 representatives from the following high-tech industries took part in the survey on the war in Ukraine and its effects: microfluidics, sensor technology, photonics/optics, microelectronics, mechanical engineering, robotics, medical technology, aerospace and metrology. Also participating were experts from the fields of research & development and higher education. The survey period was from 25.02.2022 - 02.03.2022.
